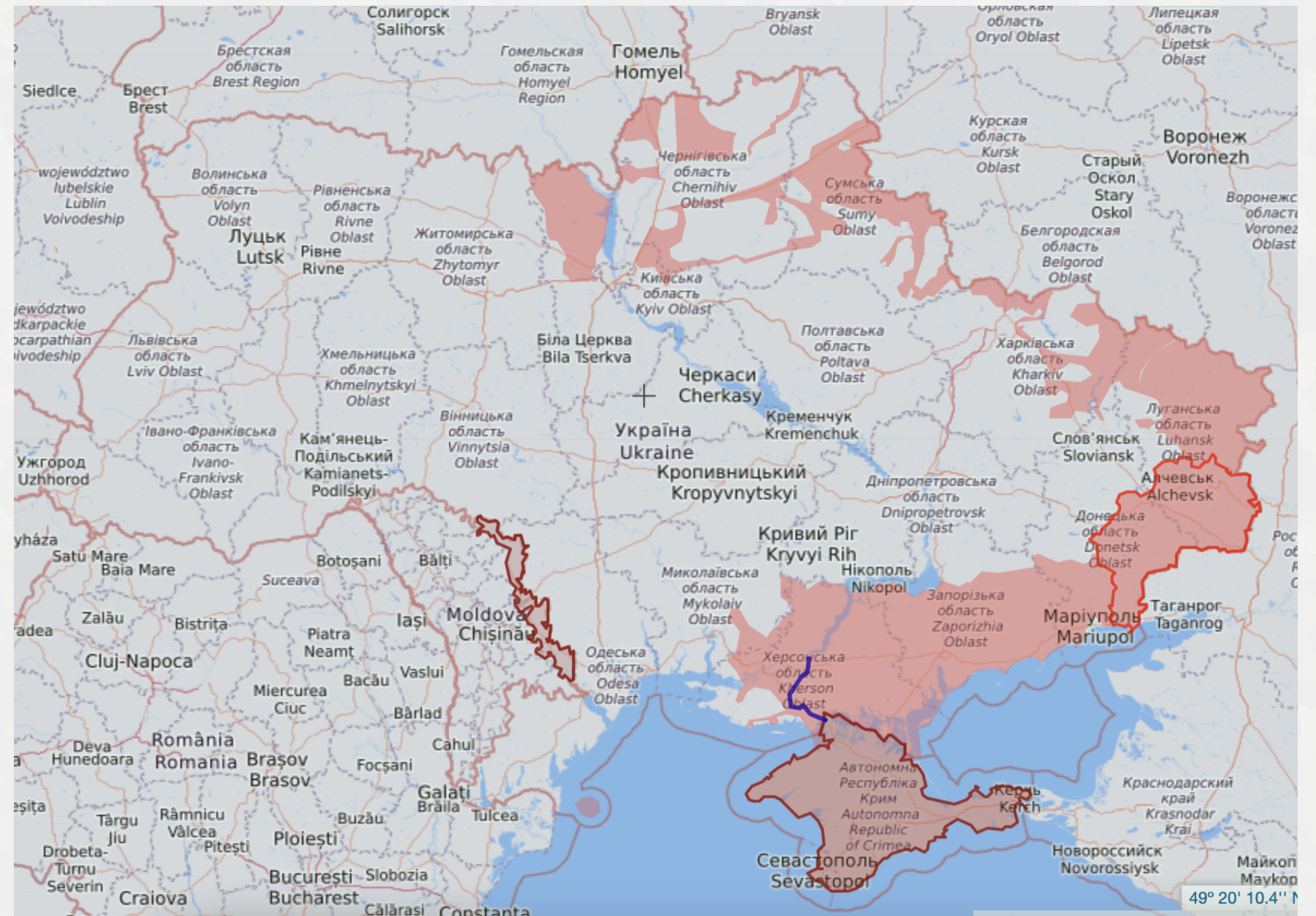


HIGHLY-RISK EXPLOSIVE TERRITORIES IN UKRAINE

NEED HUMANITARIAN DEMINING

The total area of dangerous (contaminated by explosive objects) regions of Ukraine at least

82 525 km²



EXISTING SITUATION

In Ukraine, there is no single body that coordinates all mine action activities

- 01** The Law of Ukraine was adopted on December 6, 2018 "On Mine Action in Ukraine" **accepted before the war with the Russian Federation (changes are required)**
- 02** State policy in the field of mine action **not coordinated, not effective**
- 03** On 11/10/2021, the National Authority for Mine Action was established as **interdepartmental auxiliary body** and **on a collegial basis.**



EXISTING SITUATION

In Ukraine, there is no single body that coordinates all mine action activities

There are only 2 mine countermeasures centers:

- **Under the Ministry of Defense of Ukraine –**
Mine Action Center (Chernihiv)
- **Under the State Service of Ukraine for Emergency Situations -** Interregional Center for Humanitarian Demining and Rapid Response (Kharkiv)



SOLUTION STEPS

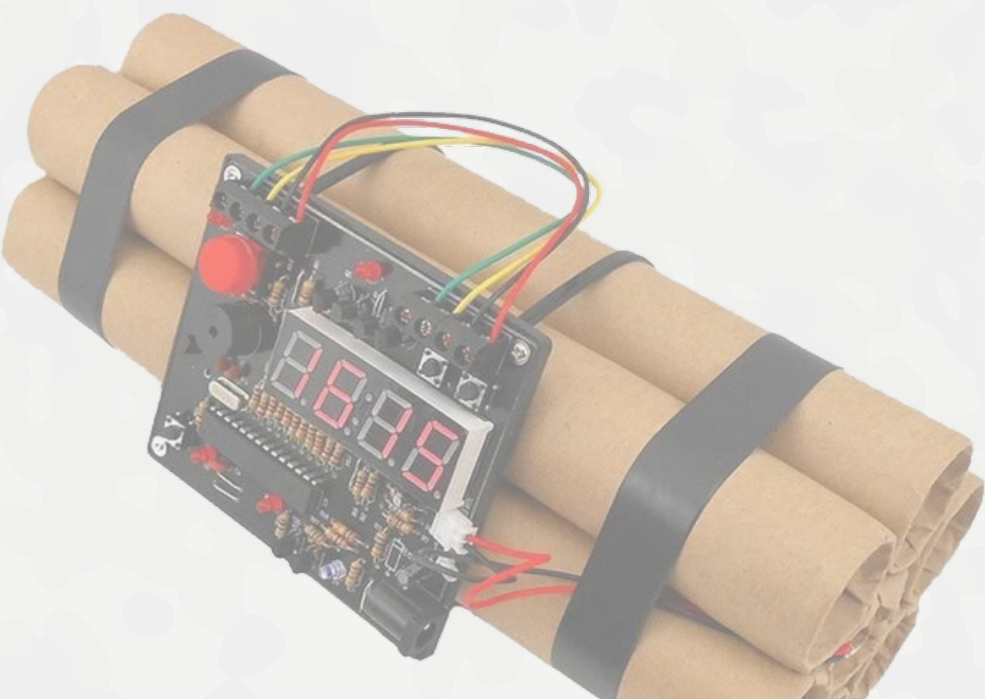
Creation of the State Agency for Mine Action in Ukraine

- 01** Decision of the authorized body on the establishment of the State Agency for Mine Action in Ukraine **(the draft is ready)**
- 02** Decision of the authorized body on the Regulations of the State Agency on Mine Action in Ukraine **(the draft is ready)**
- 03** Separation of powers of the State Agency for Mine Action in Ukraine and the National Authority for Mine Action in Ukraine

** Humanitarian demining is aimed at reducing the harmful effect of explosives on people's lives.*

PROBLEM:

In Ukraine, there is no single body that coordinates all mine action activities



SOLUTION:

Create the State Agency for Mine Action of Ukraine

PRINCIPAL TASKS

OF THE STATE AGENCY ON ISSUES OF ANTI-BREAKING ACTIVITIES OF UKRAINE

- **Real coordination of activities** of ministries, other central and local bodies of executive power, local self-government bodies, enterprises and organizations regardless of the form of ownership;
- Coordination of **international donor** aid;
- Proposals for policy formation / recommendations for **revision of legislation**, implementation of national standards for mine action in accordance with international mine action standards, rules and procedures for managing operations in the field of mine action;
- Implementation of **informational and educational programs** regarding mine action in Ukraine;
- Development of **DSTU on determining the cost of works** by types of humanitarian demining;
- Organization of the process of **improving the qualifications** of state, communal and private persons by types of humanitarian demining.

EXPENDITURES OF THE STATE AGENCY



01 **National budget.** Maintenance of the apparatus of the State Agency is estimated at **27 million hryvnias, consisting of 50 staff units.**

02 **Special fund.** Implementation of measures at the expense of contributions from donors and the possibility of implementing complex programs for several years.

The planned volume of contributions in 2022 is €250-500 million, 2023-2025 – up to €2 billion annually.
